Students wishing to major in music are admitted to the program provisionally according to a placement audition in applied music at the beginning of the first semester of study. At the end of the fourth semester, an evaluation of the progress made in both musical and academic studies will be made by the music faculty and, after a private conference with the student, a decision regarding continuation in the program will be made. Students must meet the following requirements to proceed in the music education major:

- 1. A cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or higher in all college work. A cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or higher in all music coursework for B.M.E. students.
- 2. A grade of C (2.0) or better in MUSC 101, 102, 201, 202 and 301. Any of these courses with an unsatisfactory grade (D or F) may be repeated only once.

## Required Education Courses (with grade of C or higher)

EDUC 110, 141, 201, 246, 250, 308, 321, 467, 472, 474; SPEC 230, 330 (35 hours) Students must meet all admission and retention requirements of the WVWC Teacher Education Program.

## **Other Required Courses**

EXSC 130 or 201

All majors must attain level 8 in chosen field of applied music which is normally achieved by a minimum of 12 semester hours and a maximum of 14 semester hours of study and present an assisted recital in their major performing area in their junior or senior year with or without one hour credit.

##All music majors must participate in at least one ensemble each semester with or without credit and establish a minimum of 4 hours of credit in ensemble. No more than 8 ensemble credits may apply toward the 120 hours required for graduation.

Music majors incur a reduced fee for applied music credits required for the major. Music education majors are permitted to enroll for 18 hours without an additional charge; credits above 18 semester hours will incur overload fees. Because of the heavy requirements for this degree, it is likely that the student will either have to carry an overload or extend the time required to complete the program. Completion of this degree may require more than 8 semester hours of full-time academic work.
