Students wishing to major in music are admitted to the program provisionally according to a placement evaluation in aural and written theory during Orientation and a placement audition in applied music at the beginning of the first semester of study. At the end of the fourth semester, an evaluation of the progress made in both musical and academic studies will be made by the music faculty and, after a private conference with the student, a decision regarding continuation in the program will be made. Students must meet the following requirements to proceed in the music major:

- 1. A cumulative grade point average of 2.0 or higher on all college work
- 2. A grade of C or better in MUSC 101, 102, 201, 202 and 301. Any of these courses with an unsatisfactory grade (Cor below) may be repeated only once.

## Other Requirements

- 1. Attain level 10 in one area of applied music with a minimum of 12 semester hours of study.
- 2. Give a full recital

##All music majors must participate in at least one ensemble (MUSC 149) each semester, with or without credit. No more than 8 ensemble credits (MUSC 149) may apply toward the 120 hours required for graduation.
