Five-Year Master of Business Administration at WVWC

What is the Five-year MBA?

- At West Virginia Wesleyan College, students have the opportunity to earn their Master's in Business Administration while simultaneously obtaining their undergraduate degree.

Who can apply?

- Any West Virginia Wesleyan College student, regardless of undergraduate major, who has earned at least 60 or more undergraduate hours.
- Students with a 3.0 undergrad GPA.

When can I apply?

- It is recommended that students apply after earning 60 academic hours and begin their first class after completing 75 semester hours.

How does it work?

- Students will take both undergraduate and graduate courses each semester to complete both degrees.
- Prerequisites are provided at the MBA level for those with minimal academic background in the business discipline.
- The curriculum consists of MBA core courses plus specific electives for either a standard MBA or a concentration in health care administration, nonprofit management, human resource management, or labor & law.

What do I need to apply?

Each applicant needs to:

- Complete the application for graduate admission
- Provide official transcripts for all undergraduate and graduate coursework
- Provide two recommendations, using the Graduate Recommendation Form
- Submit a Statement of Purpose for pursuing the MBA degree
- Submit a current resume
- Applicants with below a 3.0 GPA must provide an official report of the GMAT
