



ONLINE REOPENING FAQ

Question: Will the College adjust room and board charges for the fall semester?

Answer: The College will adjust the room and board charges for the fall semester over the coming weeks. Should students return to campus during the fall semester, prorated room and board charges will be added to student accounts at that time. For questions regarding billing, please contact Josh Stump at stump.j@wvwc.edu.

Question: If I have already paid for my room and board for the fall semester, can the payment be applied to future charges?

Answer: Yes. You have the option of leaving the funds on the student account or requesting a refund.

Question: If students return for in-person classes, will they be required to submit a COVID test prior to arrival?

Answer: Students will be notified at the time of announcement regarding the return to campus of the testing requirements. The next announcement regarding campus operations will be on Friday, August 28th.

Question: How will Orientation for new students be structured?

Answer: New student orientation will be held in a series of online and video events (add date). The Admissions staff will communicate with incoming students. Incoming students with further questions should reach out to their Admission's Counselor.

Question: What is the move-in date for students if in-person classes resume?

Answer: Should students return to campus during the fall semester, they will be provided with move-in information at the time that the return to campus announcement is made. The next announcement regarding campus operations will be on Friday, August 28th.

Question: What do I do if I do not have reliable internet access at my home?

Answer: If a student does not have reliable internet access at home, they should contact the Student Success Center staff at ssc@wvwc.edu for assistance in making arrangements in their home community.

Question: My parents and I believe I will be safer living at Wesleyan and in Buckhannon. Can I still come to campus and pay for the room and board?

Answer: No, the campus will remain closed except for faculty and staff until the new move-in dates are announced. The next announcement regarding campus operations will be on Friday, August 28th.

Question: Prior to the August 15 arrival date, I made arrangements to arrive early. Will I still have that option when the new arrival date is confirmed for in-person classes?

Answer: No. The campus will continue to be closed except for faculty and staff until new move-in dates are announced.

Question: I am an international student. Who should I contact with questions about my previous flight arrangements, SEVIS status, or other matters?

Question: I have an internship on my schedule for the fall semester. Who should I contact with questions regarding internships?

Question: Will athletics continue this fall?

Answer: The latest announcement from the Mountain East Conference states that competition can begin no earlier than October 1. Official practice for football can begin on September 7, and for all other fall sports on September 14. All competition that was scheduled before October 1 has been moved to the spring semester with dates to be determined. The conference may ultimately make determinations to delay certain sports based on the level of contact risk relative to existing public health conditions or other health and safety concerns.
