Transfer Scholarships

For New Students Enrolling Fall 2022 / Spring 2023

Academic Scholarships

Academic scholarships are awarded at the time of acceptance to West Virginia Wesleyan. No separate application is needed.



Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship \$18,000

Requirements: Full-time, active PTK member at a community college with a 3.5 GPA.

Presidential Scholarship \$17,000

Requirements: 3.25 GPA from transferring four-year college or accredited community college. If less than 12 hours, refer to high school criteria.

Dean's Scholarship \$15,000

Requirements: 3.0 GPA

Wesleyan Merit Award \$13,000

Requirements: 2.5 GPA

Second Degree Scholarship 50% of tuition

Requirements: Transfer students pursuing a second degree are eligible to receive a 50% tuition waiver if the student earned a 3.0 GPA while earning their first degree. *Second degree scholarships cannot be combined with any other academic awards.

West Virginia residents are able to combine the \$4,750 WV PROMISE Scholarship to any West Virginia Wesleyan academic scholarship. For eligibility requirements, please visit www.cfwv.com.

Financial Aid Checklist

- * Apply to Wesleyan online or submit a paper application by March 1st
- * Seek out and apply for scholarships (from WVWC, your guidance counselors, and beyond). Pay close attention to application deadlines. Required WVWC scholarship applications are available from the Office of Admissions.
- * Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) before March 1st. You can file online at www.fafsa.ed.gov. Wesleyan's school code is 003830. West Virginia students must submit the online application for the WV PROMISE scholarship. The application can be found at www.cfwv.com.
- * Submit your enrollment deposit and Intent to Enroll and Housing Request Form to the Office of Admissions before May 1st.

Co-curricular Scholarships

Co-curricular scholarships may be combined with academic awards but cannot be combined with other co-curricular scholarships.

Creative and Performing Arts \$500+

Awards are available in vocal and instrumental music, theatre, technical theatre, musical theatre, dance, art and writing. Auditions are required for music, theatre and dance scholarships. Portfolios and writing samples must be submitted for art and writing scholarships.

Athletic Scholarships \$500+

Accepted student-athletes who meet NCAA Division II & Eligibility Center requirements. Awards are determined by the coaches.

General Scholarships

West Virginia Wesleyan has over 600 endowed scholarships which have been established over the years by generous alumni, foundations and friends of the College. These awards range in size and are awarded based on information from a student's FAFSA. Some awards are need-based, but others are based on program of study or other student information.

All WVWC institutionally-funded merit, talent, and need-based scholarships presented here are based upon in-person instruction. All institutional grants and scholarship will not exceed total direct costs.
