Master of Science in Nursing Post-Graduate APRN Certificate

West Virginia Wesleyan College offers a **Post-Graduate APRN Certificate** in **Family Nurse Practitioner.** Post-Graduate Certificates provide nurses who have already earned a Master of Science (MSN) (or doctoral degree) in nursing, an opportunity to acquire specialized skills that may not have been offered in their graduate degree programs. The post-graduate APRN certificate ranges from 29 - 35 credit hours. Students completing the post-graduate APRN certificates will be eligible to sit for the national certifying examination as a Family Nurse Practitioner (ANCC or AANP).

Family Nurse Practitioner focuses on preparing advanced practice nurses uniquely qualified to provide primary health care to patients; they diagnose and manage acute and chronic conditions and emphasize health promotion and disease prevention.

Candidates for Admission

Program Policies: All applicants will be considered individually by the Nursing Graduate Admission Committee. Once admitted, students must maintain an unencumbered WV RN license and a 3.0 GPA for all graduate work. Applicants will not be accepted for January admission. Students will be admitted for Fall; admission is competitive to the program. **Each applicant will:**

- Be a graduate of an accredited MSN program
- Possess an unencumbered RN license
- Have a GPA of 3.0 or higher in all previous college work
- Complete the application for graduate admission to the Post-Graduate program, available at <u>www.wvwc.edu/admissions/graduate-students</u>
- Provide a personal statement of goals & objectives
- Provide official transcripts for all collegiate coursework
- Submit a current resume or curriculum vitae
- Submit three professional recommendations for Graduate Admission forms, available at www.wvwc.edu/admissions/graduate-students, one of which must be from a professional supervisor or faculty
- Submit validation of an unencumbered RN license
- Demonstrate proficiency in English if a non-native English speaker by submitting scores from the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL)
