**MINIMUM ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR TEACHER EDUCATION PROGRAM:**

1. 45 semester hours of college work in courses at the 100 level or above.
  2. A cumulative grade point average of 2.75 or above in courses at the 100 level or above and a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or above in each teaching field.
  3. Completion of each education (EDUC/SPEC) course with a grade of C (2.0) or above, and completion of EDUC 110, 201, 205/206; ENGL 102 AND COMM 211 with grade of C (2.0) or above. Any EDUC or SPEC course with an unsatisfactory grade below a C may be repeated only once. Only two EDUC or SPEC 300 level courses may be repeated.
  4. Successful completion of all sections of Praxis I.
  5. Submission of two letters of recommendation from faculty members outside the Department of Education.
  6. Submission of an autobiographical statement.
  7. Evidence of a current, negative T.B. test.
