Completion of each education (EDUC/SPEC) course with a grade of C (2.0) or above, and completion of EDUC 110, 201, 205/206; ENGL 102 AND COMM 211 with grade of C (2.0) or above. Any EDUC or SPEC course with an unsatisfactory grade below a C may be repeated only once. Only two EDUC or SPEC 300 level courses may be repeated.

4. Successful completion of all sections of Praxis I.

5. Submission of two letters of recommendation from faculty members outside the Department of Education.

6. Submission of an autobiographical statement.

^{*}Student teaching is a 12 hour total requirement. Students who pursue multiple certifications will be required to complete SPEC 478 or SPEC 479 and one teaching course in the second certification area at the appropriate programmatic level.
