Option B: Global (18 hrs or 15 hrs with a three credit minimum African, Latin American or Middle Eastern Study Abroad program)

Selected from: ENGL 230, 231, 232, GNST 350, HIST 161, 270, 273, 274, 275, 358, INDS 130, RELG 161, 240, 245, POLS 240, 326, 347, or special topics courses in the Global field may be applied to the major with permission from the International Studies Advisor.

Foreign Language Requirement

Six credits in one language or have proficiency in a foreign language indicated by CLEP examination. Additional language study is strongly recommended. The TOEFL examination will serve as a foreign language waiver for international students who do not speak English as their first language. Student may apply up to six credits in different languages if the student has been a part of a study abroad program that includes a foreign language requirement and if that course is approved by the Registrar for transfer. This foreign language requirement may not serve concurrently with the study abroad courses in the core requirements section.
