### Other Communication Requirements

Four semesters of participation in C92-FM Radio, *The Pharos* newspaper, at least two semesters of which must be in radio. In addition, Media majors must complete at least four semesters of participation with major responsibilities (e.g. executive board membership in radio or an editorial position in newspaper) in either C92-FM Radio, or *The Pharos* newspaper. Students may concurrently count their semesters with major responsibilities towards their requirements for participation.

1. Elective courses in Communication Studies are offered alternate years.
2. Students majoring in Communication Studies need strong verbal skills. Those with average and low verbal scores on the ACT or SAT or those high school English grades below B should seek help for writing and vocabulary work at The Writing Center and/or Learning Center.
