Students wishing to major in music are admitted to the program provisionally according to a placement audition in applied music at the beginning of the first semester of study. At the end of the fourth semester, an evaluation of the progress made in both musical and academic studies will be made by the music faculty and, after a private conference with the student, a decision regarding continuation in the program will be made. Students must meet the following requirements to proceed in the music major:

- 1. A cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or higher in all college work. A cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or higher in all music coursework for B.M.E. students.
- 2. A grade of C (2.0) or better in MUSC 101, 102, 201, 202 and 301. Any of these courses with an unsatisfactory grade (D or F) may be repeated only once.

## Other Required Courses

EXSC 130 or 201; All majors must attain level 8 in chosen field of applied music which is normally achieved by a minimum of 12 semester hours and a maximum of 14 semester hours of study and present an assisted recital in their major performing area in their junior or senior year with or without one hour credit.

- Non-keyboard majors are required to attain level 2 in piano which is normally achieved by a maximum of 4 semester hours of study
- Music Education vocalists are required to complete MUSC-167L Vocal Diction Lab with MUSC-167/267/367 in the fall and MUSC-167L Vocal Repertoire Lab in the spring semester.

##All music majors must participate in at least one ensemble each semester with or without credit. No more than 8 ensemble credits may apply toward the 120 hours required for graduation.

The following are alternate year courses: MUSC 222; 231, 232; 241, 242; 243, 244, 270, 275, 276.

Music majors incur a reduced fee for applied music credits required for the major. Music education majors are permitted to enroll for 18 hours without an additional charge; credits above 18 semester hours will incur overload fees. Because of the heavy requirements for this degree, it is likely that the student will either have to carry an overload or extend the time required to complete the program. Completion of this degree may require more than 8 semester hours of full-time academic work.
