



GENERAL EDUCATION CURRICULUM: INNOVATIVE, INTEGRATIVE, COLLABORATIVE

2021-2022 [Applicable only for Fall 2021 new students and Fall 2020 new students opting in]

Each candidate for graduation is required to satisfy the following distribution requirements; no single course may satisfy more than one general education requirement.

All students must complete a designated advanced writing course in each major field of study.

First-Year Experience [6 hrs.]

- FYEX-101, First Year Experience: Introduction to a Liberal Arts Education [3 hrs.] *Fall Semester*
- FYEX-102, First Year Experience: Portfolio Preparation [1 hr.] *Spring Semester*

Complete two credits from the following: (no more than one hour from each area): Spring Semester

- FYEX-103, Applying a Liberal Arts Education to Community Issues/Aesthetic Expression [1 hr.]
- FYEX-104, Applying a Liberal Arts Education to Community Issues/Cultural Expression [1 hr.]
- FYEX-105, Applying a Liberal Arts Education to Community Issues/Ethical & Spiritual Exploration [1 hr.]
- FYEX-106, Applying a Liberal Arts Education to Community Issues/Experimental Inquiry [1 hr.]
- FYEX-107, Applying a Liberal Arts Education to Community Issues/Personal & Societal Well-Being [1 hr.]

Foundations [12 – 17 hrs.]

A grade of C or better is required in ENGL-101, ENGL-188 and COMM-211; these courses are to be taken in sequential order upon entering Wesleyan

- ENGL-101, Composition I [3 hrs.] (unless waived on the basis of test scores & high school composition grades)
- ENGL-110, Written Inquiry [3 hrs.]
- COMM-211, Fundamentals of Human Communication [3 hrs.]
- One course designated as foundational scientific inquiry [3-4 hrs.]
- One course designated as foundational quantitative analysis [3-4 hrs.]

Lenses [15 - 16 hrs.]

One course required from each of the following lens categories [prerequisite FYEX-101]

- Ethical & Spiritual Exploration (ETSP) [3 hrs.]
- Aesthetic Expression (AEXP) [3 hrs.]
- Personal & Societal Well Being (PSWB) [3 hrs.]
- Cultural Expression (CEXP) [3 hrs.]
- Experimental Inquiry (EXIN) [3-4 hrs.]

Senior Year Experience [2 hrs.]

Eligibility to enroll in the senior experience requires completion of 4 lens courses with a minimum grade of C- in each course.

INDS-401, Senior Experience: Portfolio [1 hr.]

INDS-402, Senior Experience: Presentation [1 hr.]
