COURSE PREREGISTRATION INFORMATION

The Fall 2022 course schedule and supporting materials will be available online via the Wesleyan homepage under Students/Academic Services/Course Schedule Information. Preregistration will proceed according to the credit hour schedule below.

Students are responsible for entering their preferred schedule via WebAdvisor following the online WebAdvisor instructions posted in the preregistration material. Your advisor may only approve your schedule **during the designated time period listed below based upon credit hours earned**. Please refer to the preregistration email you will receive indicating your earned credit hour total and academic advisor.

Advisor Appointments

Contact your academic advisor in person or via email to inquire about the process for scheduling an advising appointment. Using the appropriate advising checksheet (available on the Wesleyan website under Students/Academic Services/Major Checksheets and listed by catalog year), plan a tentative schedule for the fall 2022 semester prior to your appointment time. Once you and your advisor have agreed upon your proposed schedule and you have entered the schedule through your WebAdvisor account, your advisor may then access and approve the course schedule during the corresponding time below. Instructions for entering your schedule into WebAdvisor can be found on the website.

Late Preregistration

Students who do not preregister during their scheduled times will NOT be permitted to preregister until late preregistration.

Students under the previous general education curriculum (Pre Fall 2021)

*Composition I, Written Inquiry, and Fundamentals of Human Communication MUST be taken in sequential order and enrollment is required each semester until sequence is completed. For example – students who are currently enrolled in ENGL 110 must enroll for COMM 211 in the spring semester.

*INDS 120 – Intro to Humanities – this course is being phased out and will continue to be taught for a short time only.

Course Load Overload

A full-time course load is between 12 and 17 total credit hours. Students who meet the criteria for a course overload will be permitted to enroll in 18 hours. Eligible students are those with at least 30 earned hours with a 2.75 cumulative GPA. **Either you or your advisor must obtain prior approval from Academic Service by emailing a request to registrar@wwvc.edu before an overload will be accepted in WebAdvisor.** Enrollment in more than 18 hours requires authorization from the Academic Dean. The course enrollment authorization form is available on line under Academics/Academic Services/Registrar Forms.

Music Ensembles

All students who will be participating in a music ensemble must register for either zero or one hour of credit. All music ensembles are listed as MUSC-149. Only 8 ensemble credits may apply toward the 120 hour minimum required for graduation. Applied music courses should correspond to student class level (sophomores should enroll in 200 level, juniors in 300 level, etc.)

HELPFUL HINTS

WebAdvisor gives you the option to search for courses by certain filters such as course day/time, department, course level (100, 200, 300, 400), instructor, etc. under the Search for Sections option. This option also indicates current enrollment information as well as prerequisites.

If a course is closed, please select one of your alternate courses. The Academic Services Office will not place students in closed general studies courses – please review other options during your advising session so that your advisor can use alternate courses as needed.

If you are not planning to return to Wesleyan for the fall semester but are not certain of your plans, we encourage you to preregister. If you are certain that you will not return for Fall 2022, please complete an Intent to Discontinue Form available online under Academics/Academic Services/Academic Forms-Students. If you do not complete an intent form and do not preregister, you will be billed for the fall semester.
