- 3. Completion of each education (EDUC/SPEC) course with a grade of C (2.0) or above, and completion of EDUC 110, 201, 205/206; ENGL 110 AND COMM 211 with grade of C (2.0) or above. Any EDUC or SPEC course with an unsatisfactory grade below a C may be repeated only once. Only two EDUC or SPEC 300 level courses may be repeated.
- 4. Successful completion of all sections of Praxis I (PPST). See specific testing information listed in the catalog.
- 5.Submission of two letters of recommendation from faculty members outside the Department of Education who have had the candidate as a student in the classroom.
- 6. Submission of an autobiographical statement.
- 7. Completion of a signed professional dispositions contract.
- 8. Completion of a student demographics sheet.
