United Methodist Ministers' Dependent Children – who are under 22 years of age and are unmarried may receive a Ministerial Grant that equals 50% of our total direct costs (tuition, fees, room and board).

West Virginia Conference & Western Pennsylvania Conferences – Dependents of full-time pastors, both lay and ordained.

All Other Conferences – Dependents of all ordained (deacon and elder) pastors in full-time appointment and to all seminary graduates who have been commissioned by their conference for ministry and are currently in full-time appointments.

THIS AWARD CANNOT BE COMBINED WITH OTHER WESLEYAN ACADEMIC AWARDS. Ministerial Grant recipients **cannot** receive the Presidential, Dean's, or Wesleyan Merit Scholarships. Recipients may be considered for the following types of scholarships – performing arts, visual arts, legacy, and athletic. Recipients are required to maintain a 2.0 cumulative grade point average. The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) should be filed to determine eligibility for need-based grants, loans, and/or work study.
