MINIMUM ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR TEACHER EDUCATION PROGRAM:

1. 45 semester hours of college work in courses at the 100 level or above.
2. A cumulative grade point average of 2.75 or above in courses at the 100 level or above and a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or above in each teaching field.
3. Completion of each education (EDUC/SPEC) course with a grade of C (2.0) or above, and completion of EDUC 101, 201, 206; ENGL 110 AND COMM 211 with grade of C (2.0) or above. Any EDUC or SPEC course with an unsatisfactory grade below a C may be repeated only once. Only two EDUC or SPEC 300 level courses may be repeated.
4. Successful completion of all sections of Praxis I (PPST). See specific testing information listed in the catalog.
5. Submission of two letters of recommendation from faculty members outside the Department of Education who have had the candidate as a student in the classroom.
6. Submission of an autobiographical statement.
7. Completion of a signed professional dispositions contract.
8. Completion of a student demographics sheet.
